

Minutes of Warleggan Parish meeting, 12<sup>th</sup> December 2013 at the Jubilee Hall, Mount

Present: 1.

Apologies:

Minutes of 21<sup>st</sup> November were read & agreed as a true record.

Matters Arising:

- It was agreed that a letter would be written by Mrs P P[redacted] to Highways to relate how the parish feels about the importance of the apostrophe in the name decided for the Ocean Housing development. (Noel's Meadow). Also regarding not wanting any street lighting. Mrs P [redacted] will also bring this up at a PACT meeting if Highways attend. (supported by Mrs D W [redacted] seconded by Mr I W [redacted])

Other Business:

- Planning application for proposed sub-division of Blejyowa, and construction of 3 bed detached house and garage at The Old Post Office, Mount.

After a discussion, a vote of the planning sub-committee supported this application 3-1 in favour (supported by I [redacted], M [redacted] & N [redacted], with I [redacted] objecting and I [redacted] & N [redacted] abstaining. Mr [redacted] did not vote as he declared an interest) with the following view to be submitted:-

"We have reservations about the amount of extra vehicles that could potentially be using the shared drive and the limitations of access onto the road. We also ask that traditional materials be used and original hedges & trees maintained"

AOB:

- I [redacted] told the meeting that the bench on the Warleggan triangle is in a state of collapse. She asked if the parish would fund a new one. It was suggested that as this year has seen the Platinum Wedding Anniversary of I [redacted] it would be nice to commemorate it to them. It was agreed that Mr J Jc [redacted] & Mr I W [redacted] would have a look at the existing bench to see if it is repairable and Mrs P P [redacted] would look into the legalities & responsibilities if the Parish was to replace it with a new one.
- Mr G Sl [redacted] brought up that, at the last meeting, he raised the question over painting the exterior of the Reading Rooms on the crossroads in Mount and it was deemed that this was not a village cost but something the players using the facilities should be responsible for. He asked why the Parish may agree to the cost of replacing a bench but not this. It was suggested the Reading Rooms might approach the Parish for a donation towards the paint.
