Minutes of Warleggan Parish Meeting 3rd October 2019, at the Jubilee Hall, Mount

Present / Apologies - see Parish Clerk's copy of the minutes for list of those (9 people) recorded as attending, and of the (2) apologies received.

The minutes of the meeting of 8th August 2019 were read out and agreed as a true record.

Matters Arising

1. **Sign for Newland Hill, Pantersbridge:** Mr John K has received an email from St Neot parish council agreeing to us placing a sign 'Ignore SatNav – no access to Warleggan village' within their parish at the start of the road. Mr John K is to be reimbursed £77.40 after paying the bill.
2. **Planning Application [PA19/04425](#) Dove Cote Warleggan** – has been withdrawn as it was likely to be turned down as it did not conform to an annex.
3. **Noticeboard Warleggan:** Mr Keith H has received a £50 voucher in lieu of his construction of the noticeboard.
4. **Fencing / cows:** Mr John K had sought to obtain the tag numbers of the bulls that are on Warleggan Downs illegally; however, he gave up when one became aggressive. Mr John K will send a letter to the Commons Committee.

Any Other Business

1. **Planning Application [PA19/07756](#)** at Higher Dewey, Warleggan for 'Removal of conservatory with extensions to north elevation' was unanimously supported.
2. **Land adjoining Noel's Meadow [PA19/01842](#):** This development will go before Cornwall Council's Planning Committee Meeting on 14/10/2019. Mr John K has requested permission to speak for the allowed three minutes and read his statement. All supported and praised this presentation. A recent soil survey carried out by Wheal Jane Consultancy has highlighted levels of arsenic are of a moderate risk level which would necessitate removal of top soil similar to Noel's Meadow. Mr John K has emailed planning officer Mr J L about our concerns as this would likely result in many lorry movements through Noel's Meadow where children play.
3. **Use of residual funds from the Carnival Committee:** those present felt that the use of these funds 'as and when needed' would be better than rushing to spend the money promptly. It was agreed that suggestions for the use of this money should be made to the

Chairman or Clerk. Mr Richard J suggested a sign for the reading room to publicise the snooker room. We agreed to draw attention to these funds through the parish magazine.

4. **Finger sign at Treslea Downs:** there was concern about the state of repair of the finger sign at Treslea Downs; we understand that the full repair of this sign would be approximately £500. Whilst we are open to helping Cardinham Parish with some contribution towards the repair, it was suggested that perhaps County Councillor grants might be sought for this [?]effort[?].
5. **Broken style:** There is a broken style in the woods on the footpath just over the cattle grid on the way to Higher Bury. Mr John K agreed to email Ms Julie B about this. It was also noted that the road to Galgeth had become overgrown.
