Matters Arising

1. Noel's Meadow: Mr Larty has pulled out of planned development of site and it has been placed for sale.
2. Mr John K has circulated received correspondence.

Parish Precept

Discussed settling the Parish Council Tax Precept for 2022-23. £1,100 has been agreed for the past six years. Having looked at the expenditure over these years it was agreed to keep it at £1,100. Ms Julie G proposed and Mr Lawrence R seconded. All in favour.

Any Other Business

1. Mr John K has donated a payment of £100 to the Christmas Lighting Committee, and £17 for a wreath. All were in favour of £117 to be reimbursed to Mr John K.
2. Queen's Diamond Jubilee 2022: In June 2022 we will have an additional bank holiday and the question was raised by Mr John K ref a parish event. Suggestion put forward included: the Big Do in the Field being brought forward; barbecue and hog roast with music and mugs for the children. Mr John K will approach the Hall Committee and suggested we meet in the New Year to set up a committee for this.
